Alfredo Lee, born into an Adventist family and a pianist every Sabbath through high school, now works for a child advocacy organization.




Edgar N. Momplaisir has attended Adventist schools for most of his life and expects to graduate from Pacific Union College in June with a degree in Film and Television.

ESRI Maps for Office is an add-in for Microsoft Office that brings mapping capabilities into Microsoft Excel and Microsoft PowerPoint all without leaving excel.

Esri Maps for Office brings mapping into PowerPoint by allowing you to include maps from Excel or maps from ArcGIS Online as slides within any PowerPoint

• Create an interactive map that includes data from Excel and ArcGIS services.


