Do you have data in excel with location information (Address, X,Y Coordinate, Zip code, etc.)?

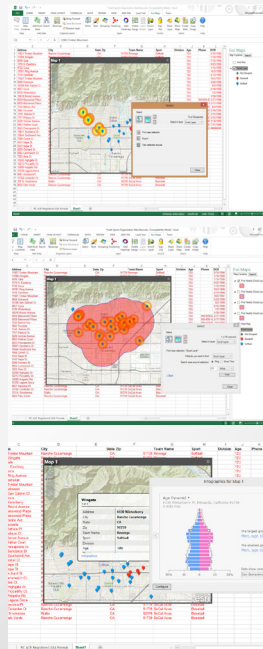
Do you wish to visualize your data on a map?

ESRI Maps for Office is an add-in for Microsoft Office that brings mapping capabilities into Microsoft Excel and Microsoft PowerPoint—all without leaving excel.

Esri Maps for Office brings mapping into PowerPoint by allowing you to include maps from Excel or maps from ArcGIS Online as slides within any PowerPoint
