

Ronald L. Numbers, Hilldale and William Coleman Professor of the History of Science and Medicine Emeritus, Wisconsin-Madison. Numbers was awarded the 2008 George Sarton Medal by the History of Science Section for William of Averaging Lendard.

Science Society for "a lifetime of exceptional scholarly achievement by a distinguished scholar," and has served as president of that distinguished society. The other track of his scholarship is American religious history, having served as president of the American Society of Church History. His particular focus here is Adventist history: Ellen White: Prophetess of Health (3 editions) and The Creationists (2 versions).


