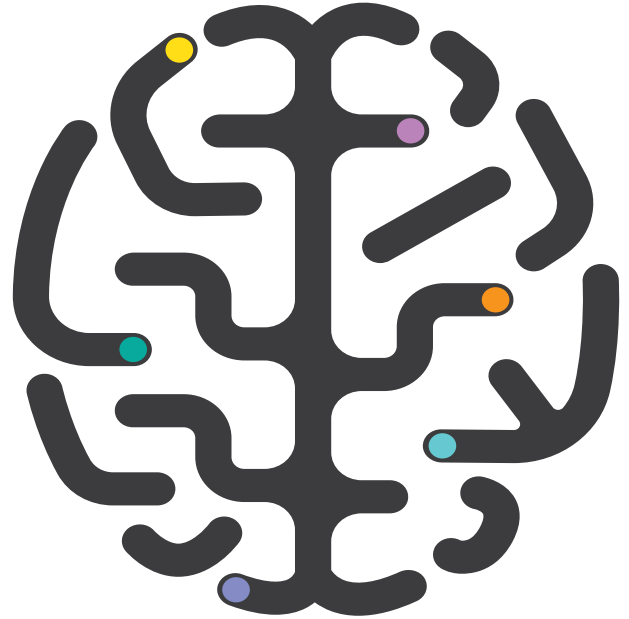

Dr. Jennings obtained his M.D. degree in 1990 from the University of Tennessee College of Medicine in Memphis, Tennessee and completed psychiatric residency at D.D. Eisenhower Army Medical Center in Augusta, Georgia. He is board certified in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, and is licensed to practice medicine in Tennessee, Georgia and Washington. Dr. Jennings was named one of America's Top Psychiatrists by the Consumer Research Institute of America in 2008, 2010, 2011 & 2012.
