- Employees and students are encouraged to submit up to ten (10) high resolution, color photos that they have personally taken.
- Images should be inspirational and promote positive feelings such as peace, strength, hope and/or joy.
- Photos **MUST** be able to be cropped to 5.5" x 3.5" in either a horizontal or vertical format without losing image impact.
- Minimum resolution - 300 dpi at final size.
- File type - jpg format.
- **Name each jpg file/photograph** with the photographer's last name, first name and location of photo.
- **Images must be submitted in digital format** on a CD or flash drive to Kathy McMillan, Employee Spiritual Care, MC Room 6700H, or via email to kmcmillan@llu.edu.
If pictures are sent from an LLUH email, the file must be deleted from the "sent mail" folder after sending.
- Include your contact information - work extension and work location.
- If photos are taken in an identifiable place, please list the location. (*flowers, animals and close ups are excepted*)
- Photos with bright colors print well and are often chosen over more muted photos.
- Images will be chosen for both adults and children staying in our hospitals.
