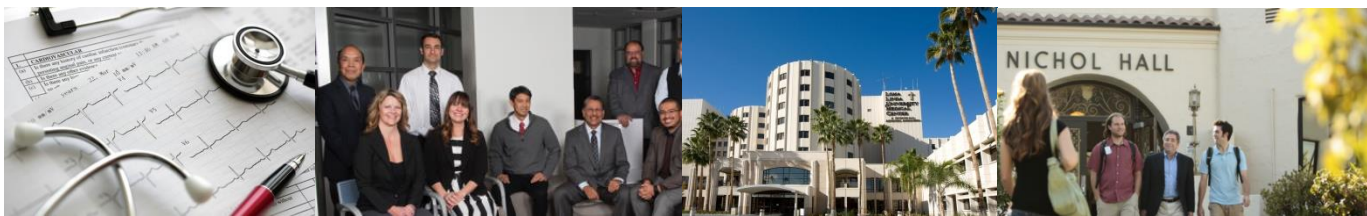




# Masters of Science Respiratory Care
