



- Our child abuse physicians take care of patients in both San Bernardino and Riverside Counties.
- We are affiliated and see patients at the Children's Assessment Center of San Bernardino (CAC), a public/private partnership between San Bernardino County and Loma Linda University Children's Hospital.
- The CAC provides forensic interviews and evidentiary medical examinations to assist in the evaluation of child abuse allegations.
- We coordinate services in a child-focused atmosphere, thus reducing trauma to child victims and their families.

- Promotes a nurturing atmosphere for children and families
- Provides referrals for treatment as necessary

- Access to specialized intensive care is often the difference between life and death for a critically ill child, and for more than 25 years, the PICU at Loma Linda University Children's Hospital has provided children with advanced medical treatment when they needed it most.
- A multidisciplinary team including physicians, nurses, pharmacists, child life specialists, respiratory therapists, physical therapists, chaplains, and other clinicians collaborate to best meet the medical, psychosocial, and spiritual needs of the hospitalized child.

- The Division of Medical Genetics is committed to providing the highest quality, state-of-the-art genetic services to patients and their families and to engaging in academic and professional activities that advance genetic knowledge and optimize health outcomes through advocacy, counseling, education, outreach, and research.
- We are a group of physicians and genetic counselors who provide consultations, risk assessments, and genetic counseling for children, adults, and their families for a variety of inherited disorders. Our genetics team offers its expertise to patients who are searching for a diagnosis for their complex or rare disorder. We strive to answer the question "why did this happen" and put an end to a patient's long and frustrating diagnostic odyssey.
- We develop and coordinate an individualized comprehensive evaluation that includes genetic and genomic testing in both inpatient and outpatient settings.
 We inform patients and families about their diagnosis and provide support groups and other resources.
- Our outpatient services include special clinics for Skeletal Dysplasias and Syndromic Obesity in addition to general Genetics clinics. We also provide genetic services to many multidisciplinary specialty team-based clinics: Metabolic Genetics and Newborn Screening Center, Cardiology, Craniofacial disorders, Cystic Fibrosis, Breast, Ovarian, Gl cancers, and cancer predisposition syndromes, and Adult Neuromuscular disorders.
- Accurate and early diagnosis can lead to better surveillance and treatment strategies for patients and their families.

- Division of Pediatric Nephrology provides services to children with kidney diseases, hypertension, and bone disorders from newborns to 21 years of age.
- We are the designated Pediatric kidney disease center for the inland empire and service the counties of San Bernardino, Riverside, and other adjacent counties.
- We provide medical management for children with hypertension, kidney and bladder diseases, fluid and electrolytes disorders, acute and chronic kidney disease, kidney failure, dialysis, and kidney transplant.


